## REGISTERED SURVEYOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ACT WITH PRIME REGARD TO PRESCRIBED CODE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND ETHICS

The Board has received a number of feedbacks on registered surveyors contravening Section 15 of the Land Surveyors (Code of Professional Conduct and Ethics) Rules. Failure to comply with the provision under Section 15 of the Rules raises unpleasant questions as to whether the registered surveyor had failed his client and the authorities by negligence, indifference, ignorance, incompetence or wilfulness and whether such acts should be expected of a registered surveyor.

- 2. The Board would therefore like to remind all registered surveyors to be fully aware of and to practise in accordance with the Land Surveyors (Code of Professional Conduct and Ethics) Rules. In particular, a practising registered surveyor should not sign on any plan, calculation, field book and other related documents of any survey not prepared or conducted by him or under his immediate supervision.
- The Board does not condone unprofessional, unethical or unlawful conduct and takes a very serious view of such breaches in professional conduct and ethics. Where appropriate, the Board will take firm action under Section 30 of the Land Surveyors Act against those who commit such improper acts.
