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LSB CIRCULAR NO. 1/2006

To whom it may concern

**SURVEY SERVICES UPON EXPIRY OF THE 4+2 YEAR TRANSITIONAL PERIOD
UNDER THE LAND SURVEYORS (AMENDMENT) ACT ON 28 FEB 2006**

1. The Land Surveyors Act requires every practicing land surveyor, and not only land surveyors who conduct cadastral surveys, to be registered with the Board. When the Land Surveyors (Amendment) Act came into operation on 1.3.2000, the Land Surveyors Board has issued Circular No. 3/2000 to inform organizations that may have engaged land surveyors for survey services.
2. The Board issued another Circular No. 1/2004 to highlight that the 4-year transitional period provided under Section 10 of the Land Surveyors (Amendment) Act would expire on 29.2.2004. On expiry of the 4-year transitional period, a further period not exceeding 2 years was granted by the Minister on a case-to-case basis. The 4+2 year grace period was to enable persons affected by the provision to sit and pass the requisite examinations for registration and for companies to meet the requirements for issue of licences by the Board.
3. Upon expiry of the 4+2 year transitional period on 28.2.2006, any person who is not a registered surveyor, or, any company that is not licensed by the Board would be contravening the Act if the person or company continues with any survey activities, including any form of advertisement for providing such survey services or tendering for contracts to provide such services.
